

Energy Labelling Directive in Europe

The Energy labelling directive 2010/30/EU prescribes that we shall be able to compare environmental data for the different products when we buy in store. Information requirements are product specific, but consist of a visible product label when displayed in store and a more comprehensive product fiche.

The requirement for labelling are now being extended to also include purchase over internet. Meaning that if you look at products on internet store you shall be able to see relevant environmental data.
